Parallel universes

From April 1 to June 1, Aurora Vigil-Escalera Art Gallery invites you to delve into the particular imagination of Moisés Yagües, Víctor López and Carol Solar in an exhibition aptly titled PARALLEL UNIVERSES.

Each of the artists opens the doors to their personal world, dominated by color, fantasy, beauty and their own concerns. Very different worlds but that run in parallel, inspired by comics and illustration, by fables and fairy tales, by games and imagination.

These three artists bring together their distinctive personal styles to provide a reflection of reality and dreams. A distorted mirror through which they show their vision of the human being. Through which they tell their own stories, tinged with feelings, memories and desires, in which each viewer will have to unravel the meaning by searching deep within themselves, in order to find in their reflection their own story to tell.

The subjective realities of Yagües, López and Solar are governed by an internal logic, different from that of our world. Full of symbology and creativity, their magical realism shows us an alternative world in which the unusual is presented as everyday and the peculiar as wonderful.

They create disparate universes in which an atmosphere contrasts, a longing for childhood with multiple layers of complexity among which there is no shortage of references to pop art and social criticism.

That is why his incredibly attractive works invite both children and adults to take part in his games and stories. To adopt an attitude towards reality in which nonsense, spontaneity and magic are not only acceptable, but necessary.

During these two months, our premises on Capua Street in Gijón are decorated with wonderful sculptures, fanciful installations and figurative painting that, as props, will become the setting for a different exhibition, which invites you to explore and discover.

Moisés Yagües (Murcia, 138,135,03916,5354) imagines the interior of the head and human body as a place where stories take place, where ideas come to life and have literal meaning. His cartoonish characters, full of energy and exuding tenderness, are already causing smiles in corners around the world after his exhibitions in Germany, Mexico, Chile, China, the United States and Japan, to name a few. References and winks to art history stand out in Yagües' imagination. This admiration for the masters is translated into 'Parallel Universes' in two recreations by Mark Rothko and Pierre Mondrian, intervened by their recurring "helpers" who, with their rollers, ladders, scaffolding and buckets of paint, strive to finish the work. These tiny characters also appear populating a Tetris game, in which they contribute to bringing order.

His figuration of surreal situations and schematic characters finds its influences in comics, illustration, pop art and street art, among others. He continues to paint in search of the freest creation and a completely personal universe, with a fresh and casual style, a well-established iconography and a desire to tell stories that has also led him to a role as an illustrator of books for children and adults. He has also been the recipient of various awards and scholarships such as the Casa Falconieri, in Italy, or the Pilar and Joan Miró Foundation, in Mallorca, and artistic residencies in China, Romania, Slovenia, Italy and Germany.

Víctor López de la Fuente (Madrid, 138,135,03945) presents us with a dream world of vibrant tones, endearing characters and impossible stories. With a figuration very close to illustration and elements that he borrows from the surrealists, López presents us with paintings, reliefs and sculptures full of criticism and irony.

An eye observes the cosmos through a keyhole, a magician plays with the galaxy like a juggler, a man lives inside a gigantic crown, light travels through the universe, is refracted in love and forms a rainbow, the stories What we hear nourishes our brain from which trees emerge with letters and ideas that fly... Symbols and allegories overflow the artist's works, whose delicate atmospheres and intense lighting contribute to building a fantastic space in which everything is possible. A scenario taken from a story, from a dream.

The works of Víctor López are a journey to the subconscious and to the hidden places of the human mind, full of a logic that, although far from that of the real world, does not seem to the viewer as something completely foreign and incomprehensible. Perhaps that is why we are not surprised to discover that he has a degree in psychology, a profession that he continues to practice today and combines with his artistic practice. Nor should we be surprised that this affinity and sensitivity for art have flourished alongside such a demanding career, since López is also the son of an artist. He has developed a large part of his career in the world of comics, in which he has won numerous awards, and, due to his attractive compositions and magnetic fables, since 1938,135,0394, he has been displaying his magic throughout Spain, as well as in Portugal, Taiwan and Mexico.

Influenced by cartoons, comics, fashion, children's stories and music videos, Carol Solar's own imagination (Santiago de Chile, 138,135,03945) exudes humor and irony, while exploring the concepts of identity, relationships, passage of time and personal space.

Through attractive colors, a drawing of simple lines and numerous references to mass culture, Solar captures apparently happy and naive scenes, but always with a disconcerting point, which reflects the infantilization to which our society is subjected contrasted with gravity. of the current times. Each character and element of the painting is distributed in such a way that the viewer feels invited to interact with it and unravel its story, which the artist herself has been developing at the same time as the painting.

His acrylics on wood are joined by a fascinating production on paper in which we see the freest color, full of geometric patterns and vegetation of South American and Asian influences, which cover the backgrounds in a reflection of the subconscious of the characters inside. Characters that she brings to three-dimensional space through her textile works, a format in which her games and sense of humor are combined with material investigations to carry out furniture, installations and sculptures that complement her personal language, which she has carried since her I study in Madrid in cities like Amsterdam, Barcelona, Seville or Santander.
